NURSING COURSES (INCLUDE LECTURE and CLINICALPORTION)

GENERIC: Minimum pre-requisites before registering for NURM 121: BIO 105, CHE 114, ENG 101, NURM 100, NURM 119.

NURSING COURSES: NURM 121–Nursing I (8cr.); NURM 122–Nursing II (8cr.); NURM 221–Nursing III (9cr.); NURM 222–Nursing IV (9cr.).

Generic Day: Every nursing course is offered each semester - both for the day and evening sessions.

ACCELERATED: Minimum pre-requisites before registering for NURM 141: All the above listed general education courses except NURM 119.

NURSING COURSES: NURM 141–Accel. Nursing I (13cr.); NURM 241–Accel. Nursing II (11cr.); NURM 242–Accel. Nursing III (13cr.).

This track is offered FULL-TIME, DAYS ONLY.

LPN-TO-RN: Minimum pre-requisites before registering for NURM 120: All the above listed general education courses except the two Humanities requirements. **NURSING COURSES:** NURM 120-Transition (4cr.); NURM 221-Nursing III (9cr.); NURM 222-Nursing IV (9cr.).

NURM 120 offered once/year; 4 weeks beginning at the end of May until the middle of June.

PATHWAYS TO BSN: Pre-enrolled semester: BIO 105, CHE 114, ENG 101, PSY 101. First School of Nursing semester: BIO 106, BIO 108, ENG 102, NURM 100, NURM 119. Remaining curriculum mixes Union College of Union County NJ and Kean University courses with the JFK Muhlenberg Snyder School of Nursing clinical nursing courses: NURM 121 (8cr.), NURM 122 (8cr.), NURM 221 (9cr.), NURM 222 9 cr.). DAYS ONLY.

NOTES: Only grades of “C” or above will be considered for transfer. A maximum of 36 relevant general education credits may be considered for transfer. Holders of BA/BS degrees may transfer in 40 relevant credits.

Anatomy and Physiology I & II and Microbiology must be taken within the last ten years to be transferable. Chemistry has a 10 year limit to be transferable.

*Humanities may be taken from Literature, Modern Languages, Philosophy, History or Fine Arts courses. Consult the new Union College of Union County NJ Catalog. CHE 113 and CHE 114 may be needed for transfer into a BSN program.
