In the past, funds have helped support patient care, purchase state-of-the-art equipment and technology and made renovation projects possible - such as the transformation of floors 2 North and 2 West into private rooms.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

Unrestricted gifts allow us to complete large projects that make a tremendous impact on health care in our community. Riverview Medical Center is focused on planning for the future, including: the renovation of the Alton A. Hovnanian Emergency Care Center; advanced telemetry; new furniture and equipment; and other upgrades to improve patient care. Additionally, the renovated Emergency Care Center will feature a secured health crisis unit and a designated CT unit.

Over the last few years, we have seen a 50% increase in patient volume to our Booker Women's and Children's Center, which is why funding to this area is crucial. Additional resources will help fund a new 3D tomosynthesis machine, an ultrasound machine and the relocation and expansion of the Women's Health Center.

At Riverview Medical Center, private rooms have become a highly regarded necessity. Private rooms provide patients with a low-stress, high-comfort environment in which family members are more engaged in the health care process, which aids in healing and improves patient satisfaction and physician-patient communication. Riverview Medical Center plans to add more private rooms in the near future.
