Located on a 110-acre scenic campus in central New Jersey, Carrier Clinic has been providing innovative and exceptional behavioral health care since 1910.

Carrier Clinic offers inpatient, residential and educational services to adolescents who suffer from emotional, psychiatric, behavioral and/or addiction illnesses. Services take place in a healing environment designed to strengthen self-esteem and support consistent, positive behavioral growth.

Child and Adolescent Inpatient Psychiatric Program

Short-term inpatient care for adolescents with acute psychiatric and/or dual disorders needing crisis stabilization. Opening in May 2026 is a specialized children's unit treating ages 7-12, which also includes an expansion of available beds for ages 12+ and a family resource center to serve as a hub for learning and understanding. With this expansion, Carrier will be home to the largest child and adolescent inpatient behavioral health unit affiliated with a children's hospital in the state.

East Mountain School
