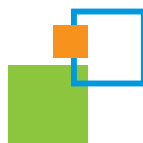




URGENT CARE WITH BEHAVIORAL HEALTH



It can be challenging to know where to go when a child or teen is experiencing a mental health related issue.

Review to know when and where to go:

The EMERGENCY ROOM is the appropriate fit for a child or teen when:

- Behavior is actively erratic/aggressive, suicidal or being violent towards themselves, others, or property.

URGENT CARE is the appropriate fit for any child or teen when:

- There is a mental health concern (of any kind) where there are no immediate safety risks. Some of our most frequently treated areas include:
 - Depression
 - Anxiety & Panic Attacks
 - Stress
 - Insomnia
 - Substance abuse
- Persistent and immediate needs for treatment without a wait for an appointment.

A walk-in place for answers:

Be seen immediately by a behavioral health clinician who specializes in pediatric and adolescent care.

****No Appointment Necessary - Receive Immediate Access to Care****

Our goal is to stabilize the patient, address concerns, provide treatment, and recommend an appropriate level of follow-up care, whether it be an appointment with a behavioral health professional or hospital care.

Frequently utilized services:

- School clearance letters where there are no immediate safety risks.
- Pediatric and adolescent expert psychiatric evaluations and treatment
- Prescription refills
- Crisis intervention
- Expedite the follow-up process with a long-term psychiatric team
- Medication initiation or adjustment
