Ruth Mitchell Award

Ruth Mitchell was an instructor at the Muhlenberg School of Nursing. She served the nursing profession passionately with a focus on outstanding patient care. The Ruth Mitchell scholarship was established to address the needs of nursing students. However, merit would be considered in the disbursement of this award to the amount of \$500 per semester to three (3) nursing students (one days, one evenings and one LPN).

Eligibility Requirements:

1. The student must have a minimum cumulative 2.7 GPA in the prior semester of the professional nursing programs
2. The student must show a documented financial need
3. The student must show evidence of being a patient care/nursing champion
4. Student demonstrates volunteerism by serving on the student government association, acting as a class representative, or volunteering in his/her community.
