■ **Inpatient Palliative Care Consultation:**

Our inpatient palliative care consultation program is offered at our network hospitals.

■ **Outpatient Palliative Care Consultation:**

At our Hackensack Meridian *Health* Nursing & Rehabilitation facilities, a palliative care referral-based outpatient consultation program is offered.

■ **Home-based Palliative Care Program**

A home-based service that offers nursing, social work and spiritual visits for support of patients and their families.

■ **Outpatient Practices**

Center for Integrated Palliative Medicine is an outpatient program for patients dealing with a serious illness.
